NOTE: The person named on the front of the sheet is responsible for the following:

- 1.) To provide volunteer workers for the major work days scheduled.
- 2.) To provide volunteers to help collect & handle birds and crates on the release date(s). Clubs are strongly urged to supply their own carrying crates. When necessary, each club will need to make arrangements to pick up OCFS crates and return to the Jamesville Correction Facility the same day of the release in order other clubs may reuse.

Participants should arrive 45 minutes ahead of schedule & plan on remaining 45 minutes after scheduled time to help collect & handle pheasants.

*******3.) BIRDS TO BE ORDERED BY May 30, 2022 *******

Donations to cover the cost of feed etc will be\$7.50 per bird.

****Bird requests will NOT BE HONORED without a MINIMUM of 50% of donation due in June - Balance Sept 1st.** Donations should be by Club check with applications..

- 4.) **JAMESVILLE CORECTIONAL FACILITY POLICY** mandates the following:
 - ** No women or children under 18yrs of age EXCEPT when prisoners not on site (pm & S&S).
 - ****No firearms, knives, any form or weapon or animals.**
 - ****Everyone entering must coordinate arrival & have valid I.D. to enter at expected times.**
 - **Vehicles to be parked without blocking the road & kept locked at all times.

5.) **RELEASING REGULATIONS:** The Onondaga County Federation of Sportsmen's Clubs operates the "Pheasant Release Program" for the benefit of the member clubs and under the direction, rules & policies of the New York State D.E.C. Division of Fish & Wildlife. Requirements dictate that pheasants are reared for recreational hunting purposes and birds be released on land open to the public hunting. 2022 release sites will be published on DEC website.

A signed statement (Page 3) is required for pick up by the responsible person ordering these birds stating where, when, and by whom the birds will be released and asserting that birds will be released as per D.E.C. rules & policies. Website access info to follow.(Apr 2022)

Additionally, this year we will begin to add the locations of DOC participant release sites onto a interactive map on the NYSDEC's website. As in all past years of participation in the program, it is a key requirement that the location where your pheasants are released is open to and accessible to pheasant hunting and hunters. This new addition to the website will allow better utilization of a public resource. Private properties may continue to be used as release sites and by agreeing to the terms and conditions of program participation you are and never have been required to let hunters pursue any other game besides pheasants on those privately held lands listed as your release site. Landowners may still require hunters to stop and ask permission before pursuing pheasants on the listed property and ASK Permission stickers are advisable and available by contacting your regional DEC Wildlife office or staff at the Reynolds Game Farm.
