As in all past years of participation in the program, it is a key requirement that the location where your pheasants are released is open to and accessible to pheasant hunting and hunters. This new addition to the website will allow better utilization of a public resource. Private properties may continue to be used as release sites and by agreeing to the terms and conditions of program participation you are and never have been required to let hunters pursue any other game besides pheasants on those privately held lands listed as your release site. Landowners may still require hunters to stop and ask permission before pursuing pheasants on the listed property and ASK Permission stickers are advisable and available by contacting your regional DEC Wildlife office or staff at the Reynolds Game Farm.
